

The Life of Bertrand Russell in Pictures and His Own Words

Compiled by Christopher Farley and David Hodgson. Spokesman Books. 96 pp. in stiff wrappers.

This beautiful and reasonably priced volume is now available through the McMaster University Library Press. It was first published in 1972 for the Bertrand Russell Centenary.

The format is unusual but pleasing. Photographs of Russell's family and friends, places he lived in, and events in his life are matched with quotations from his writings, making the volume a pictorial autobiography.

Many of the photographs are new.
