A SECONDARY BIBLIOGRAPHY OF ZHANG SHENFU ON RUSSELL

Tere are Zhang's translations of Russell's writings and his own writings about him. Sometimes an article will contain both. The articles are arranged in chronological order. It has not proven practicable to match the translations with Russell's originals on the basis of titles alone. Nevertheless, to those familiar with Russell's bibliography, many of the titles are suggestive of well-known writings by him. The Chinese titles are transliterated in the Pinyin system.

Unless a different name is given, it may be assumed that Zhang published the item under the name of Zhang Shenfu. The asterisked, incomplete entries are taken from a letter from Zhang to the Archivist dated 9 September 1985.

The illustration opposite is the opening page from his bibliography of Russell published in late 1920.
