Several of Russell's books were published without an index. In the case of *Portraits from Memory and Other Essays*, this lack is especially unhelpful. Its pages are abundant with cultural, historical and personal references, as well as recurring themes.

The edition of *Portraits from Memory* here indexed is George Allen and Unwin's edition, published in London in 1956. A pagination table is provided for Simon and Schuster's edition, published in New York in 1956.

This is the third in a series of reader-supplied indexes that began with Michael Radner's personal name index to *An Essay on the Foundations of Geometry* (1897) in *Russell*, no. 8 (1972), and mine to *Human Society in Ethics and Politics* (1954) in n.s. 11 (1991). Indexes to the rest of Russell's unindexed books are welcomed. Following the approach of the *Collected Papers of Bertrand Russell*, bibliographical indexes are needed, too.—Ed.
