The previous general update of correspondence and manuscript acquisitions appeared in *Russell*, n.s. 21, no. 2 (winter 2001–02): 157–65. There are 55 entries in the correspondence listing below covering c. 135 items. Received in November 2004, the latest acquisition number reported is 1,457. The manuscript listing of 11 items brings the total to 617 entries. The latest manuscript acquisition is 1,440, received in March 2004.
